

HOW TO READ STATS

GP – Games Played, the number of games a player has played during the season.

G – Goal, the amount of goals a player has scored during the season.

A – Assist, credited to the last player or players that passed the puck to the goal-scorer. (Up to two players may receive an assist for each goal).

PTS – Points, a player is awarded one point for a goal or assist.

+/- – Plus minus, a number given to the players on the ice when an even-strength or shorthanded goal is scored. Players on the ice for the team scoring the goal are given a plus one, players for the team scored against get a minus one.

PIM – Penalties in Minutes, the number of penalty minutes a player has accumulated.
